Today, the Rector's Office at the University of Copenhagen submits the draft strategy for the new University of Copenhagen for hearing at KVL, the Danish University of Pharmaceutical Sciences (DFU) and existing faculties at the University of Copenhagen. DJF Geodata available at the library

Since 1975, the Department of Agricultural Production and Environment (JPM) at the Danish Institute of Agricultural Sciences (DJF) has been gathering and storing a range of data. Previously, it was only possible to order copies of soil data for local areas or properties from DJF. The information available consists of a colour code card (scale 1:50000) which shows the top soil texture classified into eight categories. There is also information about landscape elements and the deep-soil clay/sand content, about the occurrence of low bottom areas and the result of the ochre classification in Jutland. These data are now available on a CD-ROM which can be borrowed for use in the library. The data may only be borrowed by KVL staff and students for use in assignments regarding KVL. The data must not be passed on to others. Geodata CD-ROMs may be borrowed and used on the PCs at the library (on the first floor, on the reading room PCs or on your own laptop). The CD-ROMs must not be copied. Further information about Geodata can be found on DJF Geodata's website www.djfgeodata.dk/datasaml/index.html.
